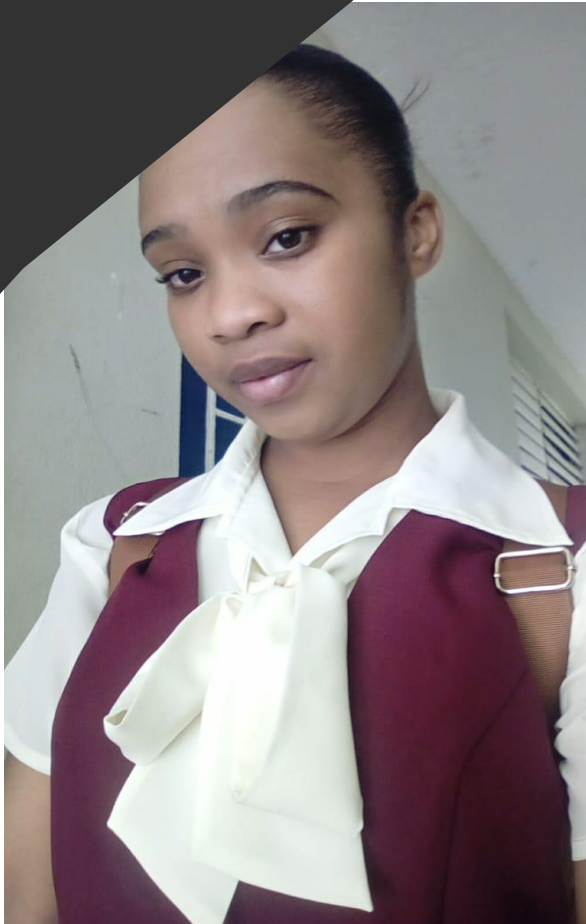

PRIMARY EDUCATION

This programme seeks to expose teachers at the primary level to training that will equip them with skills, knowledge and competencies necessary to prepare students for pursuing higher levels of education. The duration of this programme is four(4) years.

MATRICULATION REQUIREMENTS:

Candidates must have passes in five CXC/CSEC subjects, including English Language, Mathematics and a Science subject or Social Science subject at grades I or II.

A Bachelor in Education Degree in Primary Education is designed to train individuals to teach at the primary level, as well as creating specialist teachers for the primary curriculum. It also prepares students to develop their abilities to reflect and analyze their practice and make appropriate judgments in the classroom for the benefit of learning.



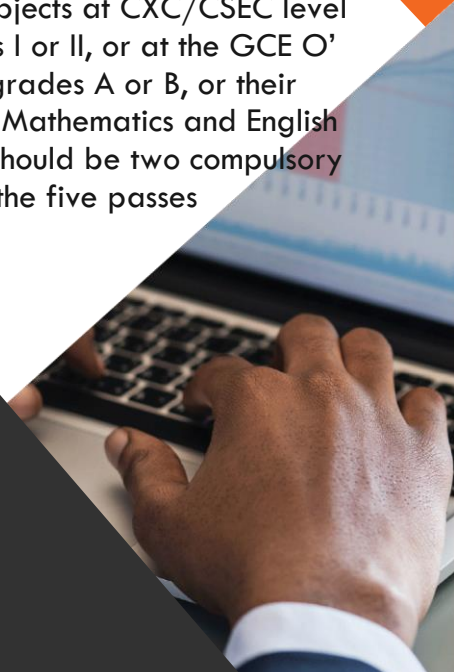
SECONDARY EDUCATION

A bachelor's degree in secondary education prepares a teacher to work at the 7-9 and upper level of the high schools system

The Bachelor of Education Degree is offered full-time for persons entering with CSEC subjects for a period of four (4) years and 120 credits. However, on a part-time basis the programme may be offered to persons who are upgrading from a Diploma in Teaching or a specialized Associate Degree. This usually takes two and a half years and only requires 60 credits.

MATRICULATION REQUIREMENTS:

To be admitted to the Secondary Education programme, candidates must have passes in five subjects with their teaching subjects at CXC/CSEC level with grades I or II, or at the GCE O' Level with grades A or B, or their equivalent. Mathematics and English Language should be two compulsory subjects of the five passes



SECONDARY SUBJECT SPECIALIZATIONS:

- Mathematics
- Computer Studies
- English Language
- Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics)
- Social Studies

MATRICULATION OF CANDIDATES VIA MATURE ENTRY:

Candidates over the age of thirty (30) years seeking admission into the programme, who do not have any qualifications but at least five (5) years of teaching experience in a recognized institution may be accepted if, clear evidence of their competence within the field is established. Also, candidates must undergo an assessment on the job by a team constituted of the Joint Board of Teacher Education and CASE.
